



## <sup>1</sup>Research Definition

Research is defined as a systematic investigation, study or experiment designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge. The term encompasses basic and applied research (e.g., a published article, book or book chapter) and product development (e.g., a diagnostic test or drug). The term includes any such activity for which research funding is available through a gift, donation, grant, cooperative agreement, contract or other award instrument between the institution and the donor.

## <sup>2</sup>Other Limits Definition

**Other limits** include time & effort certification, intellectual property provisions, budget restrictions, audit provisions, publication restrictions, human and animal subjects, export controls, university personnel subject to institutional conflict of interest monitoring plans, controlled substances, hazardous materials, foreign or remote locations, licenses, permits, compliance with Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI), Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, Foreign influence or other items regulated via the electronic proposal routing approval form (ePRAF).
